Thank you for considering National Honor Society for the school year 2011-2012! To be considered as a prospective inductee to the Southwest Chapter of National Honor Society you must complete the Activity and Volunteer section, giving examples of how you have been involved in our school and the community, what you have participated in outside of school, and any volunteer opportunities/hours you have logged (this applies to any volunteer activities from middle school to present).

- A list of those accepted will be posted on the NHS bulletin board following winter break.
- The NHS advisors, Mrs. Platikanova and Mr. Rees, will send an email to all of the teachers with a list of students who qualify to apply. The email will request the teacher to respond with a list of students who have not demonstrated good character in the classroom. If two teachers respond with your name, you will no longer be considered.
- You can submit your application to either room 113 or E115.

Selection Process:

- To be eligible to apply to NHS, candidates must display academic excellence with a cumulative GPA of around 3.5.
- Members of the board and faculty advisors will review the selection of members.
- If any part of the application is incomplete (no essay, no activities, or volunteer activities) the application will not be considered.

- The only role GPA plays in the selection process is the eligibility to apply.
- There is no process for appeal.

This application is due December 23, 2011. The Induction Ceremony will be held January 19, 2012 in the Auditorium.

Thank you for your application, and all accepted members will receive their acceptance letters between January 11 and January 18, 2012.
